





BIRD Registry Financial Plan

BIRD is building a national IBD database, known as the 'BIRD Registry', using the UR-CARE platform, provided and developed by IBDIM, the research unit of the European Crohn's and Colitis Organization (ECCO). This will allow for the collection of IBD data captured in standard of care practice in a user-friendly and uniform manner.

The BIRD Registry will be encouraged as the most optimal platform within BIRD to conduct retrospective studies on epidemiological, safety and efficacy data on a vast area of patient types and medication classes, and to obtain a comprehensive overview of IBD characteristics and demographics at a national level, which will be made available each year in a summary report.

The BIRD Registry is intended for research purposes and to improve daily clinical care. It is not designed for direct industry use. However, to ensure financial sustainability, BIRD offers several options for BIRD partners to engage with the BIRD Registry:

1. Unrestricted support

Unrestricted support starts at €15,000 for one year and is available exclusively to BIRD partners. Benefits include:

- Display of the partner's name/logo on BIRD Registry communication materials
- Logo placement on the BIRD Registry website page: <https://www.birdgroup.be/en/bird-registry>
- Discount on the annual summary report of the previous year (created in the current year), depending on the amount of sponsored support:

BRONZE sponsor: €15,000: 15% discount on the 2025* annual summary report

SILVER sponsor: €20,000: 40% discount on the 2025* annual summary report

GOLD sponsor: €25,000: 60% discount on the 2025* annual summary report

PLATINUM sponsor: Over €30,000: 100% discount on the 2025* annual summary report

**Please note that for sponsors contributing in 2025, the discount may be applied to the 2026 Annual Summary Report.*

- Opportunity to request an ad hoc report at additional cost (cost depends on the workload of the BIRD (Office) team) to add as annex at the annual summary report. Each ad hoc request must be approved by the BIRD Registry Steering Committee, SciCom and the Governing Board.



2. Annual summary report

Annual summary reports, containing anonymized and aggregated data on basic patient characteristics, will be created each year (in Q1-Q2, based on the data from the previous year with data closure in December of that year) for scientific purposes to gather national epidemiological data (including data about treatment patterns). These summary reports are comparable to current marketing surveys and vary in detail, as determined annually by the BIRD Registry Steering Committee and confirmed by the Governing Board.

Each BIRD partner can request this summary report at a fixed annual price, which will vary based on the number of patients enrolled in the BIRD Registry database and the level of data detail. The fixed price for the 2025 Annual Summary Report, including aggregated data about the patient demographics, disease location, extra-intestinal manifestations and treatments, is €10,000. Sponsors of the BIRD Registry will receive a discount based on their level of support, as detailed above.

3. Ad hoc request

Ad hoc requests, available only to sponsors providing unrestricted support, involve an additional cost and will be added as an annex to that year's annual summary report. Sponsor must submit a detailed request to the head of the BIRD Registry Steering Committee (lieven.pouillon@imelda.be) and to the COO of BIRD (ingrid.arijs@birdgroup.be) for review and approval by the BIRD Registry Steering Committee, SciCom and the Governing Board. The additional cost depends on the workload of the BIRD (Office) team. Following review by BIRD, the sponsor will receive a formal response, the associated cost and the estimated date of delivery (which may be later than the date of delivery of the annual summary report).

4. Grant support for specific investigator-initiated retrospective project


BIRD partners can support specific investigator-initiated retrospective projects within the BIRD Registry. Retrospective projects are strictly investigator-initiated and support is unrestricted to the outcome of the project. Scientific protocols are independently drawn by the investigators only, and each project will require approval by SciCom and the Governing Board. These projects must adhere to BIRD's internal guidelines which will be provided when the project is proposed to the BIRD partners. The requested budget required will vary depending on the project.



The BIRD Registry

The BIRD Registry represents a significant step forward in understanding and managing IBD in Belgium. By participating in and supporting this initiative, BIRD partners have the unique opportunity to contribute to the advancement of IBD research and the improvement of patient care at a national level.

The financial support options outlined in this plan ensure the sustainability of the Registry while allowing partners to engage meaningfully with the IBD research community. We invite our BIRD partners to join us in this important endeavor, working together to enhance the quality of care for IBD patients across Belgium.
