

RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP INFLAMMATORY BOWEL DISEASES AT AMSTERDAM UMC

The IBD team in Amsterdam is offering an open position for a Research Fellow in Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD), starting in 2026. This is a 1–2 year, full-time fellowship suitable for a postdoctoral researcher or junior gastroenterologist with a strong interest in clinical and translational research.

The fellowship will focus on collaborative research projects with Alimentiv, a Canadian–Dutch contract research organization (CRO) specializing in clinical trials in IBD.

Amsterdam UMC hosts one of the largest academic IBD centers worldwide and is internationally recognized for its innovative research. A major research focus of the center is advanced imaging, particularly endoscopy and intestinal ultrasonography.

The primary aim of the fellowship is to work with artificial intelligence models for endoscopy and ultrasonography, with a specific emphasis on their application in IBD clinical trials.

For candidates fluent in Dutch, participation in clinical duties at Amsterdam UMC is possible. Candidates who do not speak Dutch may participate in clinical activities in an observational capacity; however, training in ultrasonography remains possible regardless of language proficiency.

The fellowship includes frequent interaction with investigators at Alimentiv in Canada, with opportunities to spend time at their office in London, Ontario.
