

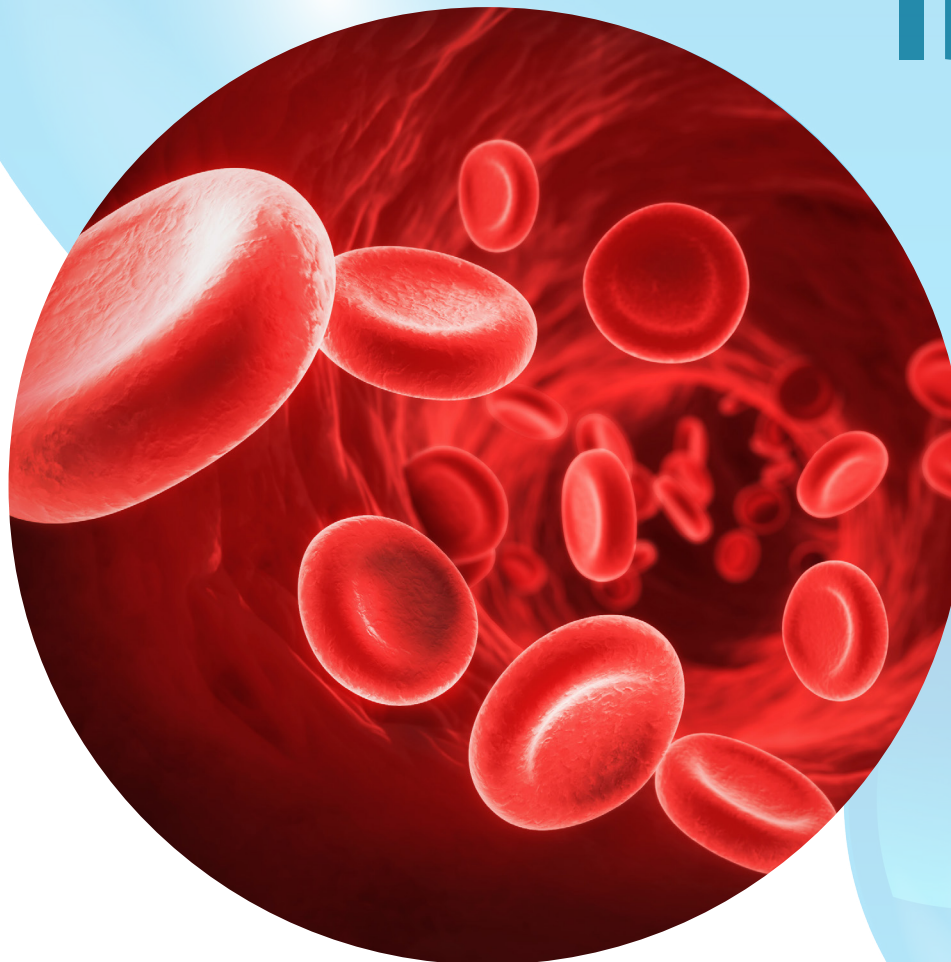
Anemia is the most common extra-intestinal manifestation of IBD which, in most cases, results from an absolute or functional iron deficiency.

Although anemia and iron deficiency may have a dramatic impact on the quality of life of IBD patients, they are underdiagnosed and undertreated. By providing consensus guidelines and practical treatment algorithms, the Belgian IBD research and development Group (BIRD) wants to increase awareness and knowledge among clinicians to improve the management of anemia and iron deficiency in their IBD patients.

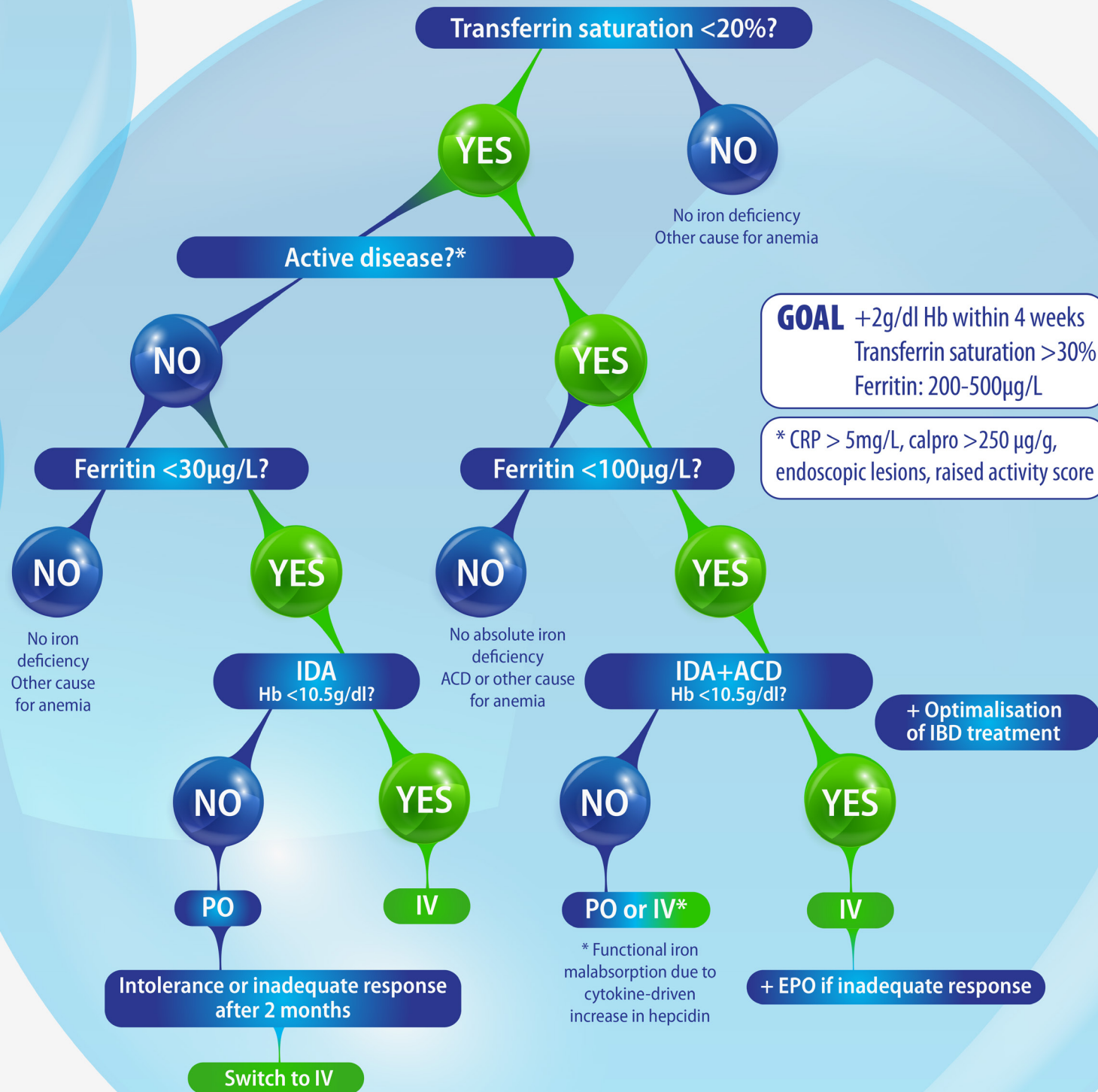


TREATMENT OF ANEMIA IN IBD
